BRUSH PICK-UP GUIDELINES



Brush will be picked up the 3rd Thursday of each month starting in April and ending November.

During scheduled brush collections, the Street Department will make only one pass through the town to pick up brush. Please have your brush by the front curb, but not in the street, by 7 a.m. The piles of brush are required to be trash-free. Please remember crews cannot access the piles if blocked by vehicles.

Branches and limbs required to be less than 8 feet in length and if there is more than one pile, a clear separation between piles. The purpose of the brush pick-up service is to assist residents with maintenance of trees and bushes on their properties.

Materials such as rocks, bricks, pipes, wire, fencing material (split rail, wood posts), lumber, etc., are to be disposed of at the county landfill. Small sticks (smaller than a broom stick), twigs, leaves, and other small debris such as this should be bagged or placed in trash cans for normal trash pick-up, following their yard waste removal regulations. The Town's brush crew will not pick up this type of material.

Remember that any contractors or workers you hire (professional tree trimmers, landscapers, builders, etc.) are required to remove from your property any tree limbs, trunks, logs, etc. that they generate. They are NOT allowed to place this material at the curb.
